A meeting of IQAC was held on 21st October, 2023. The following decisions were taken regarding submission of assignments and tests for the semester Ist, IInd and IVth -

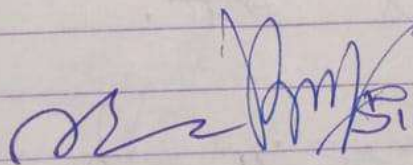
1. Two assignments will be taken from B.A./B.Com. II & III class students till November end.
